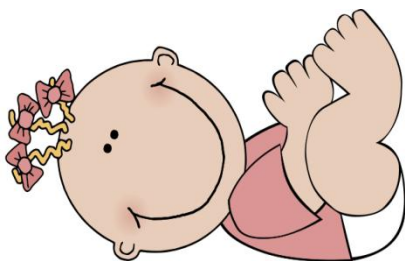

First Saturday Devotion to Mary's Immaculate Heart

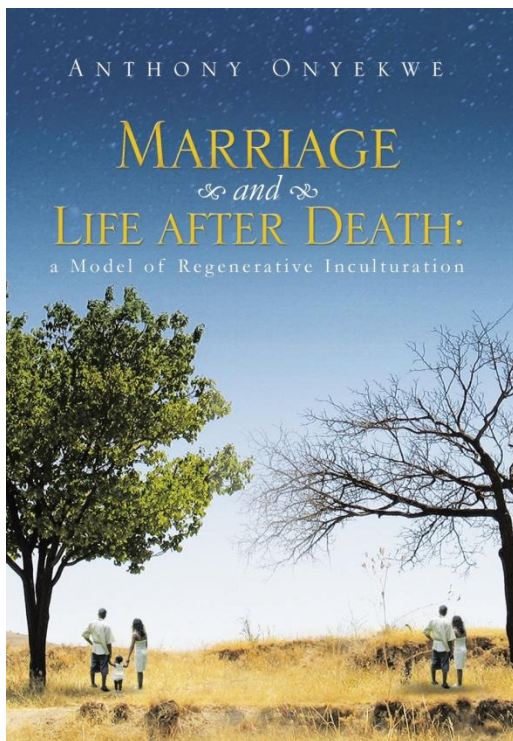
September 5, 2015 we will have our first morning Mass devoted to Mary's Immaculate Heart. The details are currently being worked out.
