## Preparing a Home for the Christ Child

How Blessed is our Mother Mary, to be chosen as the immaculate vessel to contain within her the Son of God! The thought of the divine descending to Earth in order to reside with humanity, through the Blessed Virgin, should evoke within us deep, awe-inspiring reverence.

In reflecting on our activities, thoughts and practices, we should focus on making clean those areas of our lives that may run contrary to the way of Christ. In doing so, let us resolve to recommit our way of life to the teachings of Jesus Christ and His Apostles. Let us renew our zeal to the timeless traditions and culture of the Holy Church, and let us increase our love for our neighbours.

Preparing our souls to serve as a divine habitation of the Lord requires patience and personal undertaking. To begin, if you have not already done so, take the Sacraments of Confession and Penance and the Eucharist more seriously. In doing so, you will be making a better accommodation so that Christ can dwell within you.

The Christ Child desires to be spiritually born within us. Let us prepare our souls so that He has the best accommodations. Let us cast out all that is disagreeable to the Way of Christ. If we wish to have Him dwell within us, we must give Him the chief seat of our heart and soul.

May we always echo the words of the psalmist David, when he said, "A clean heart create for me, God; renew within me a steadfast spirit." (Psalm 51:12, NABRE)
