

Third Annual Holy Rosary Eucharistic Conference

Mar. 11-12, Holy Rosary Catholic Church, 4851 Park Ave. On Friday night Stations of the Cross begin at 7 p.m. In the parish sanctuary, followed Dr. Lawrence Feingold's presentation on the event's theme "The Jewish Roots of the Eucharist." Feingold, a Jewish convert to Catholicism, is associate professor of philosophy and theology at Kenrick-Glennon Seminary in St. Louis. Dr. Feingold is both an artist and a theologian with a master's degree in art history from Columbia University in New York and a doctorate in sacred theology from the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross in Rome, Italy. On Saturday, Mar. 12, the conference begins with Mass at 8:15 a.m. Followed by presentations by Msgr. Victor Ciaramitaro, pastor of St. Michael Catholic Church in Memphis, at 9:30 a.m. And Dr. Feingold at 10:30 a.m. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction will follow Dr. Feingold's speech. Lunch will be served at 12:30 p.m. The event is free with on-site registration at 6:30 p.m. Friday or 7:30 a.m. Saturday. Or pre-register at <http://www.holyrosarychurchmphis.org/>.
