TACOS: to make these we need ground meat, cheese, chopped lettuce, shredded cheese, taco sauce and sour cream

Quesadillas: A quesadilla is a wheat tortilla or a corn tortilla filled with cheese, a savory mixture, and/or vegetables, often cooked on a griddle, then folded in half to form a half-moon shape.





Burritos: A burrito is a type of Mexican and Tex-Mex food, consisting of a wheat flour tortilla wrapped or folded into a cylindrical shape to completely enclose the filling. Fillings could be beef, chicken, pork or a breakfast version with eggs, sausage, cheese and other veggies.

Refried beans: Refried beans is a dish of cooked and mashed beans and is a traditional staple of Mexican and Tex-Mex cuisine, although each cuisine has a different approach when making the dish. Great served with melted cheese and taco chips.





The Ebelings are bringing tamales! **A tamale** is a traditional Mesoamerican dish made of masa, which is steamed in a corn husk or banana leaf. The wrapping is discarded before eating.

Dr. Joyce will share her version of **Chili relleno**! The **chili relleno** is a dish of Mexican cuisine that originated in the city of Puebla. It consists of a stuffed, roasted, fresh poblano pepper, sometimes substituted with a non-traditional Hatch chili, Anaheim, pasilla or even jalapeño chili pepper.

Enchiladas: An enchilada is a corn tortilla rolled around a filling and covered with a chili pepper sauce. Enchiladas can be filled with a variety of ingredients, including meat, cheese, beans, potatoes, vegetables or combinations.
