The Season of Lent

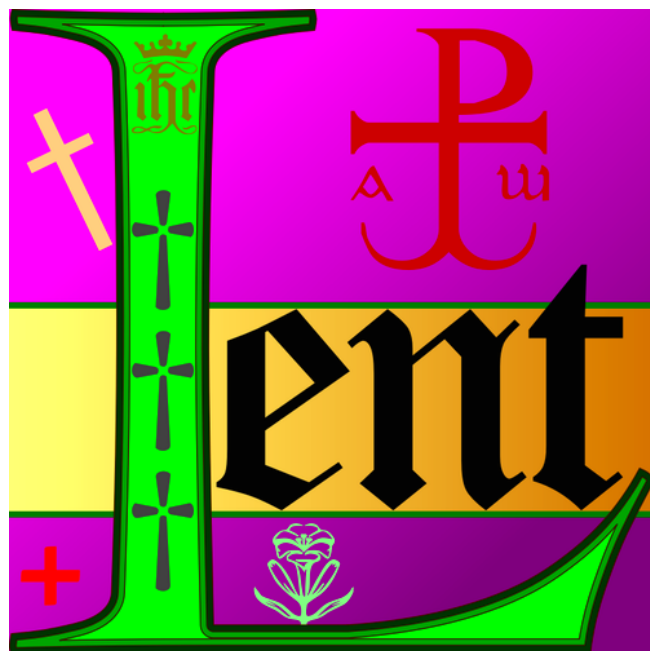
