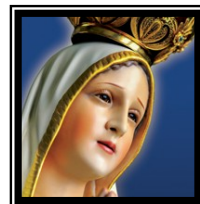

Many families travel far from home and spend several weeks or months to get treatment for their seriously ill or injured children – a long time to be away or to divide a family. And, for children facing a serious medical crisis, nothing seems scarier than not having mom and dad close by for love and support. A Ronald McDonald House is that “home-away-from-home” for families so they can stay close by their hospitalized child at little or no cost.

Our Houses are built on the simple idea that nothing else should matter when a family is focused on the health of their child – not where they can afford to stay, where they will get their next meal or where they will lay their head at night to rest. We believe that when a child is hospitalized the love and support of family is as powerful as the strongest medicine prescribed.

FYI Clinic Appreciates Your Help!

Thanks to Holy Family's and St. Mary's participation, this year's baby bottle campaign has been a huge success. In the above photo, Fr. Anthony presents a \$1,000.00 check to Ms. Dykstra for the FYI foundation. Donations from our baby bottle campaign brought in exactly \$997.73.

The FYI Clinic is a non-profit medical clinic specializing in early pregnancy diagnosis. Since 2008, FYI Clinic (formerly Life Choices Pregnancy Help Center) has offered compassionate peer-counselors and truthful information with no fees or strings attached. It is through friends of FYI Clinic, who contribute to our organization, that they can provide services at no cost.

At FYI Clinic, the medical staff and client advocates can provide safe and confidential services; free ultrasounds to confirm viability, cardiac activity, and approximate gestational age. Our own Knights of Columbus raised the monies to purchase the ultrasound machine.
