# Are You Interested In Becoming A Eucharistic Minister?

If you would like to become a Eucharistic Minister, please check with the parish office for training dates and times.

The following list of criteria is required for all Eucharistic Ministers by the Diocese of Lansing:

- Have received all the Sacraments of Initiation, Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation
- Are active in the sacramental life of the Church
- Are registered members of the parish
- Are people of mature and demonstrated faith and high school age and older
- Are effective Christian witnesses
- If married, are in a marriage which is recognized and accepted as valid by the Catholic Church.
