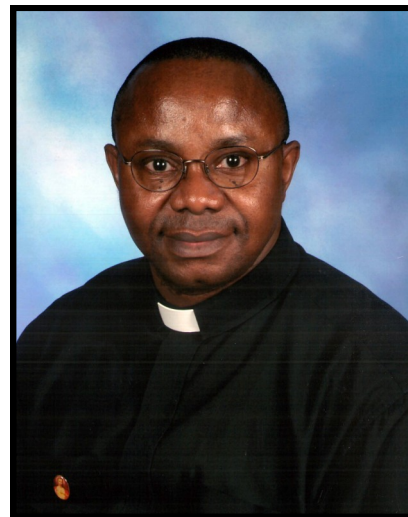
First Friday of the Month –
