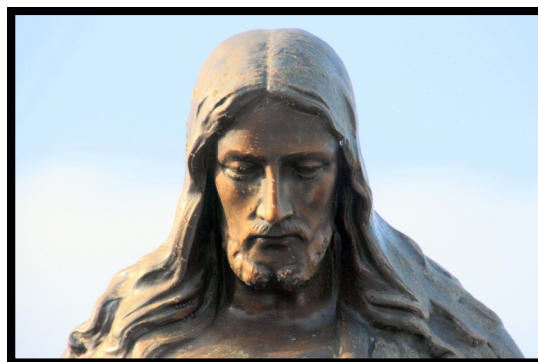

PRE NEWS

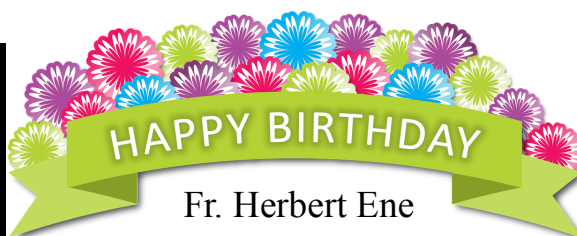
