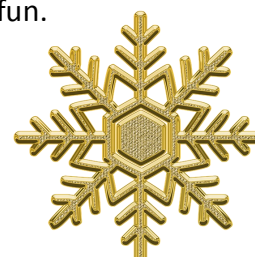

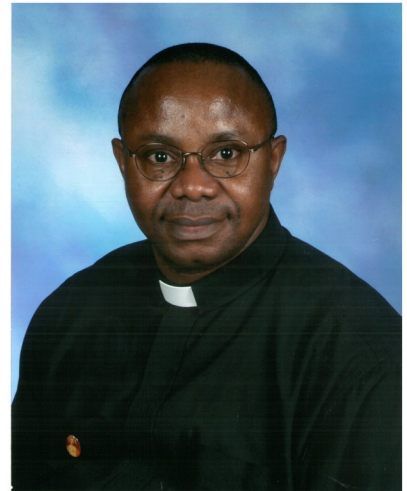
Pastor's 2018 Christmas Message
