"Summer Christmas"

The Nativity of St. John the Baptist

Behold, one is coming after me; I am not worthy to unfasten the sandals of his feet. - Acts 13:25

Each year, on June 24, we celebrate the anniversary of the birth of the child who would become known as John the Baptist. In the early ages of the Church, John's nativity was a holy day of obligation, which was celebrated with three Masses, similar to Christmas.

Since John's birth was six months before the birth of Jesus, it was the custom in the northern hemisphere to call it "Summer Christmas." When both John and Jesus were adults, Jesus called John the greatest person of the Old Testament.

John called Jesus the greatest one of all time. Christmas has become overly diversified with commercial trappings, minimizing the true meaning of Christ's birth. 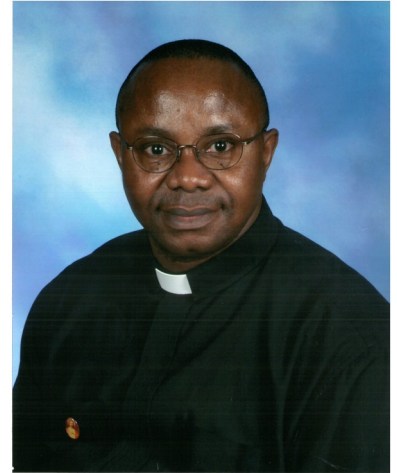
