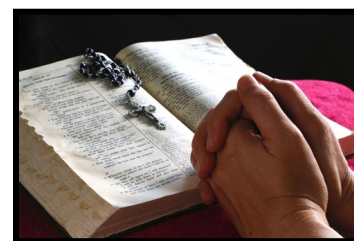
First Saturday of the Month –

Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus—June 8th

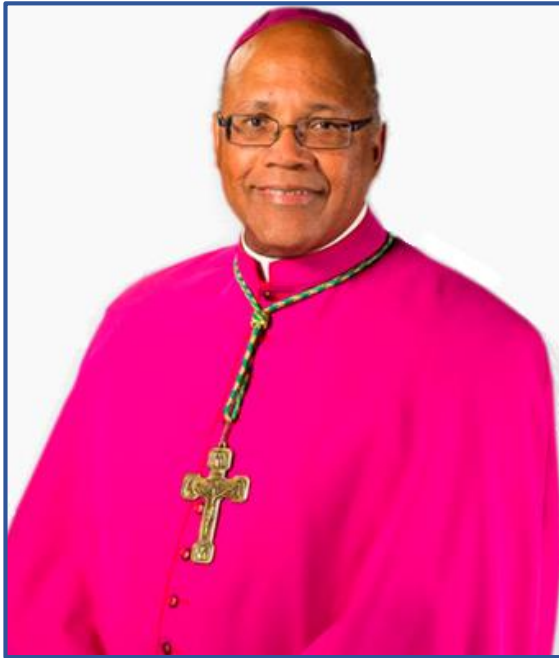
But God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us. - Romans 5:8
