Mother Mary and Mothers

In the Ten Commandments, right after the first three that detail our relationship with God, the very next, the fourth, concerns our parents.

The Catechism (963) has this to teach us about Mary: "She is 'clearly the mother of the members of Christ' ...since she has by her charity joined in bringing about the birth of believers in the Church, who are members of its head," quoting from Vatican II's Lumen Gentium (Dogmatic Constitution on the Church).

"Mary has truly become the Mother of all believers," said Pope Benedict XVI in his encyclical *Deus Caritas Est* (On Christian Love). "Men and women of every time and place have recourse to her motherly kindness and her virginal purity and grace, in all their needs and aspirations, their joys and sorrows, their moments of loneliness and their common endeavors. They

constantly experience the gift of her goodness and the unfailing love which she pours out from the depths of her heart." What a Mother she is to us.

So how can we narrow honoring a Mother like this to only one day a year? Or only a few days? Or only a month? Look at the example Jesus gave us for honoring our mother and our Blessed Mother in the way he kept the fourth commandment and ultimately from the Cross giving her to us as our Mother, too, when he did that through St. John.

John Paul II highlighted this truth in his encyclical *Redemptoris Mater* (On the Blessed Virgin Mary in the Life of the Pilgrim Church), when he wrote: "It is also true of every disciple of Christ, of every Christian. The Redeemer entrusts his mother to the disciple, and at the same time he gives her to him as his mother. Mary's motherhood, which becomes man's inheritance, is a gift: a gift which Christ himself makes personally to every individual." (Joseph Pronechen; copyright National Catholic Register)
