Mark Your Calendar!!

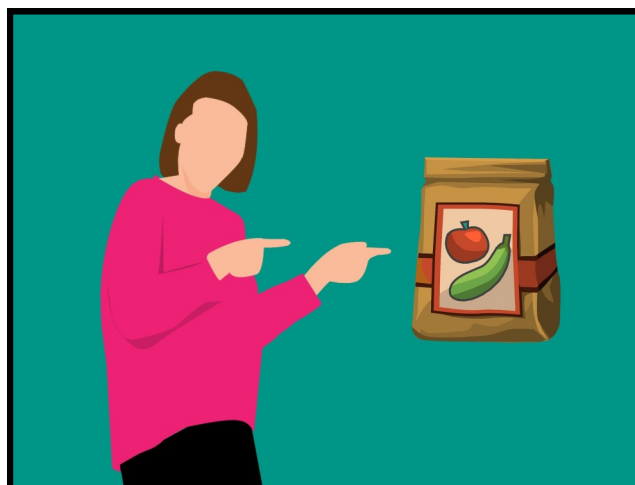
St. Mary's invites all members of our Parish to participate in our Brown Bags for the Food Pantry in Benton County to help re-stock their critically low shelves.
