### Food Bank

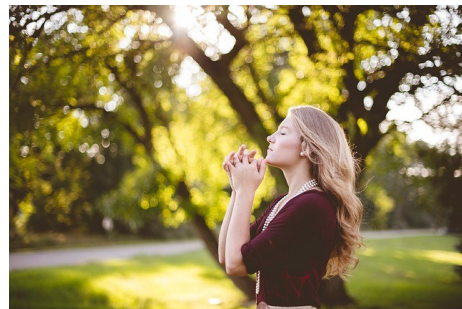
