PLEASE Wear Your Face Mask!

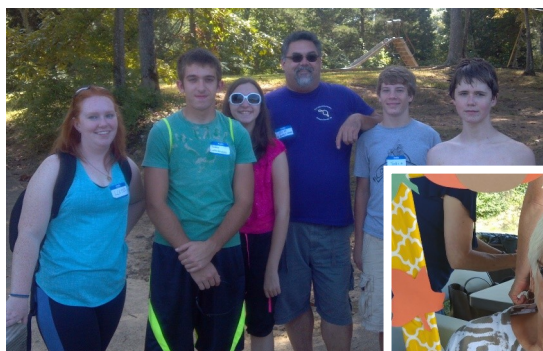
