The Responsorial Psalm today is based on verses 9-14 of the 85th Psalm, which reads: "I will listen for what God, the Lord, has to say; surely he will speak of peace to his people and to his faithful. May they not turn to foolishness! Near indeed is his salvation for those who fear him; glory will dwell in our land. Love and truth will meet; justice and peace will kiss. Truth will spring from the earth; justice will look down from heaven. Yes, the Lord will grant his bounty; our land will yield its produce. Justice will march before him, and make a way for his footsteps." (New American Bible)

The ancient Israelites were persecuted by all the surrounding enemies, with trials constantly coming up against them from the heathen nations. The Psalmist expresses the fact that Israel waited for deliverance from the hand of God. They prayed for His guidance and put their trust in Him, awaiting the long promised Messiah.

How great and merciful is our Father's compassion toward all of His children, and especially toward those who put their faith (trust) in Him. The Lord's people know, like the Psalmist who penned the 89th Psalm, that God's mercy and faithfulness is great. *"I will sing of your mercy forever, Lord proclaim your faithfulness through all ages."* (v.2)

During these turbulent times in the history of our world, may each of us keep faith in our Lord and His promises to see us through all trials. Our trust in Jesus Christ is essential. May we, with confidence, praise God for His never ending mercy and faithfulness toward those who fear Him.
