### The Need for Outside Discernment

When he returned from his missionary journeys, the first thing Paul always did was to meet with the elders of the Church to tell them what he saw and to discern with them where God was working and where things had not gone so well (Acts 14:27-28; 21:18-21). Paul felt the need for insight, discernment, and approval. He wanted his work to be guided by the Church.

Likewise, when Peter returned from the house of Cornelius, he too explained what the Holy Spirit did, and he received blessings, support, and confirmation that what happened there really was God's work (Acts 11:1-18).

These passages tell us that we can hear from the Lord. We can know his voice and be guided by his hand. They tell us also that while we can make good decisions by listening to his voice, we need to discern what we are hearing.
