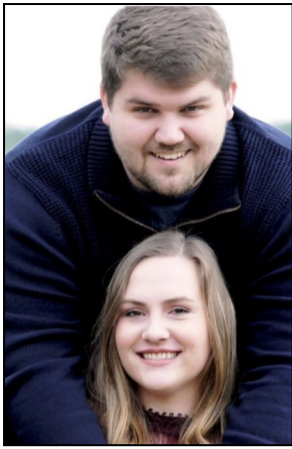

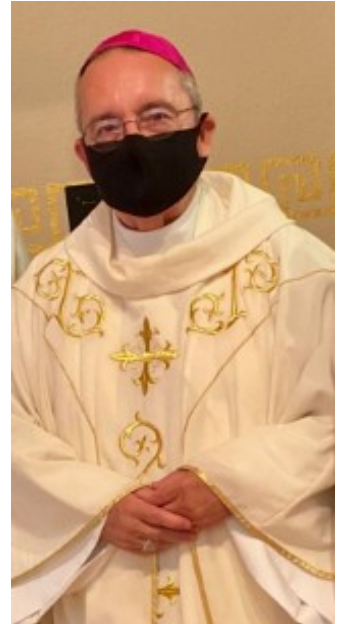

**PLEASE, FOR OUR SAFETY AND THE  
SAFETY OF OTHERS,  
LET US ADHERE STRICTLY TO THE  
NEW DECREE ISSUED  
BY OUR BISHOP AS WE CONTINUE THE  
CELEBRATION OF PUBLIC MASSES.**



**FIRST**, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation continues in effect through the **4<sup>th</sup> of September 2020.**

In particular, ***those who are experiencing any sickness and their caregivers, those with any health vulnerability, those fearful of the possible infection of COVID-19, and those with small children should stay at home.***

**SECOND**, please, follow the required instructions and restrictions listed below:

1. The withholding of the Cup of blessing (Chalice for Holy Communion) and the withholding of physical exchange of peace during Mass continues in effect through the **31<sup>st</sup> July.**
2. All **C.D.C. guidelines** for personal hygiene are to be followed (***hand washing and sanitizing***). Facial covering (**Masks**) are to be worn, through **31<sup>st</sup> of July.**
3. Reception of Holy Communion (***the Body***) is by hand only.
4. No ***Social gatherings*** in the Parish of more than fifty (**50**) people in any one room or enclosed space, through the **31<sup>st</sup> July.**
5. **Aisles** and **Pews** were marked to help us keep the required "***Social Distances.***" Keep to the markings.
6. Ushers and greeters will help in directing **families and individuals** where to sit for the Mass. Please, obey them.
7. Keep to the recommended **six [6] feet social distance** during ***Holy Communion procession,*** and both on entering and leaving the Church.
8. ***Sanitizers and wipers, etc.*** are provided. Use them to clean your own **pews/seats** after the celebration, and also the ***Restroom door handles*** after use.
9. There will be **no passing of baskets during offertory** collection. Drop your ***offertory/donation*** in the baskets placed near the entrance door or the one in front of the Altar.

Please, adhere to those restrictions and instructions given in the **DECREE** emailed to you.
