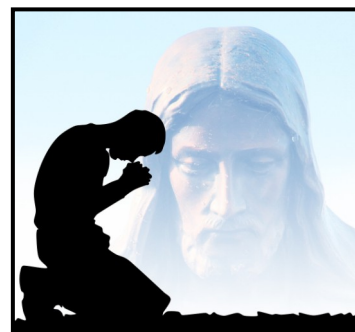
PRAY FOR DIVINE WISDOM
