EMPOWERED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT

"On the evening of that first day of the week ... Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, 'Peace be with you.' When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.' And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained."" (St. John 20:19-23)

Christ commissioned His disciples to continue in the work of His ministry, empowering each of

them with the Holy Spirit. He told His disciples, "As the Father has sent me, so I send you ... Receive the Holy Spirit."

With the power of the Holy Spirit being "breathed on them", they were given the authority to forgive or retain sins. This power, coming from Christ and through the Holy Spirit, was a special consecration. This consecration of the Holy Apostles is continued today in the Church's bishops and priests, who have the same authority as the first century Apostles to administer the Holy Sacraments, including, but not limited to Ordination and Confession.
