## ABANDONING OURSELVES TO JESUS

“Whoever seeks to preserve his life will lose it, but whoever loses it will save it.” Luke 17:33

Jesus never fails to say things that cause us to stop and think. This verse is an example of that. He presents us with an apparent paradox. Trying to save your life will be the cause of you losing it, but losing your life will be the way you save it. What does this mean?

This statement especially goes to the heart of trust and surrender. Basically, if we try to direct our lives and our future by our own effort, things will not work out. But calling us to “lose” our life, Jesus is telling us that we must abandon ourselves to Him. We must allow Him to be the one who directs all things and guides us into His most holy will. This is the only way to save our life. We save it by letting go of our own and letting God take over.

The level of trust and surrender is very difficult at first. It’s difficult to come to the level of complete trust in God. But if we can do just that, we will be amazed at the fact that God’s ways and plan for our life is far better than we could ever come up with on our own. His wisdom is beyond compare and His solution to all our concerns and problems is perfect.

Reflect upon how ready and willing you are to give complete control of your life to our merciful God. Do you trust Him enough to let Him take complete control?
