#### THE LOVE OF THE SACRED HEART

As we come to the close of the month, we continue to contemplate the love of the sacred Heart. While the entire month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart, we are encouraged to reflect Christ's love daily, throughout the year. Here are five points to ponder.

Spend time in prayer, reflecting on the love of the Scared Heart. "All I will give you a new heart, and put a new spirit within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and will give you a heart of flesh. (Ezekiel 36:26) Ask Jesus to fill your heart with His love and help you share that love with others.

Show compassion to those around you. "Bear ye one another's burdens; and so you shall fulfill the law of Christ." (Galatians 6:2) Just as Jesus seeks out and heals the lost and broken, we too are called to be His hands, demonstrating His love and mercy.

Forgive those who have wronged you. "And be ye kind to one another; merciful, forgiving one another, even as God hath forgiven you in Christ." (Ephesians 4:32) The Sacred Heart is a heart of forgiveness, always ready to welcome back the repentant sinner.

Serve those in need. "And the king answering, shall say to them: Amen I say to you, as long as you did it to the one of these least brethren, you did it to me." (Matthew 25:40) Whether through acts of charity, kindness, or simply being present for someone, let the love of the Sacred Heart inspire your actions.

Develop a devotion to the Sacred Heart. "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with thy whole heart, and with thy whole soul, and with thy whole strength." (Deuteronomy 6:5) This can be through prayers, novenas, or simply keeping an image of the Sacred Heart in your home as a reminder of His love.
