Joy finds its true source in Christ, a wellspring that never runs dry. Unlike the quickly fading pleasures of the world, the joy we find in Christ is enduring and unshakeable. Jesus said, "I have said these things to you so that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be complete." (John 15:11) He offers not merely a temporary happiness, but a fullness of joy that is anchored in His presence and His promises.

The Apostle St. Paul calls us to "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, Rejoice." (Philippians 4:4) He is speaking of a joy that transcends circumstances, rooted in our unbreakable relationship with Christ. Such joy does not vanish in trials or losses, but instead holds firm because it springs from faith in Christ's victory and His steadfast love. In all things our joy remains because we trust that our lives rest securely in His hands. This joy in Christ is cultivated through intimacy with Him. When we abide in prayer, partake in the Sacraments, and dwell in His Word, we open ourselves to His lifegiving presence. In Psalm 16:11, David proclaims, "You show me the path of life. In presence there is fullness of joy; in your right hand are pleasures for evermore." As we draw near to Christ, He fills us with a joy that becomes and integral part of our being, transforming us from within.

Our joy, too, is a witness. When others see in us a joy that is resilient and pure, they glimpse the power of Christ alive in us. This joy calls others to Him, as they begin to wonder what source sustains it. Through our joy, we become vessels of hope, reflecting the light of Christ and inviting others to discover its divine origin.

In Christ, joy is no longer a fleeting emotion but a lasting state of heart. United in Him, we possess a joy that neither the world nor circumstances can take away. Christ is our foundation, out hope, and indeed, our unending joy. (Rev. Fr. Charles)
