OUR SPRITUAL MOTHER

The blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of Our Lord Jesus Christ, holds a singular place in the economy of salvation. She is not only the one through whom the Word became flesh, but also the spiritual Mothers of all the faithful. At the foot of the Cross, our Lord declared to the beloved disciple, "Behold thy mother" John 19:27). In that moment, Christ entrusted Mary to the whole Church. From then on, she has interceded for the faithful, guiding them with maternal care, ever pointing to her Son and saying, "Whatsoever he shall say to you, do ye" (John 2:5).

The Church has always recognized in Mary the model of perfect disciple-ship. Her fiat-"Be it done unto me according to thy word" (Luke 1:38)-was a bold assent to the divine will. She accepted suffering, obscurity, and sorrow for the sake of God's plan, and she did so in silence and humility. Her birth was a preparation for this role, and her Assumption into heaven a testimony to the promise of resurrection. We rightly honor her not as a goddess nor as a rival to Christ, but as the most exalted of all creatures.

It is most appropriate that we petition our spiritual mother, asking her intercession before the throne of her Son. She is not dead, but alive in Christ, and she hears the cries of her children. The Church has always taught that all grace comes from Christ, but it also teaches that Mary, as His Mother, plays a unique role in dispensing those graces. Just as she once bore Him in her womb, now she bears our petitions in her heart. To honor her is not to distract from Christ, but to magnify Him-as she herself said: "My soul doth magnify the Lord" (Luke 1:46)

In this time of confusion and spiritual rebellion, Mary remains the sure

refuge of sinners and the crushing heel against the serpent's head. She is not a sentimental ornament, but a terror to demons and the guardian of Christian purity. We must not neglect her. The Rosary, the Angelus, and the Marian feasts are armaments in the battle for souls. The faithful must draw close to her, not with idle sentiment, but with firm conviction and devotion, knowing that the path to her Son is more easily walked when she walks with us.


